We bring the season's greetings to you. We thank God for bringing us to the end of this term. We return all glory to Jesus Christ for His grace, mercy, protection, provision and providence. We also thank you for believing in us. It is our prayer that the good Lord will keep giving us the wisdom and the resources to train our children as our hearts desire in Jesus' name. Here are some vital information for your perusal and necessary action.

## **RESUMPTION DATE AND TIME**

- Students are to resume on the 6th January, 2018 from 10:00 am 4:00 pm. Parents are encouraged to kindly respect the timing because the school gates will be closed by 4:00 pm and no student will be allowed in after wards. Please note that there shall be no admittance into the college on Sunday. Week-days (Mondays—Fridays) resumption is between 3:00 pm and 5:00 pm.
- We expect all students to resume in their approved school uniforms
  (compound wear), using the correct school dressing code. We do <u>not</u>
  expect any student to resume wearing any form of slippers. <u>All male</u>
  students are to resume wearing very low haircut. <u>Any student that</u>
  violates the above instructions will not be allowed into the school.
- Second term duration: 6th January 2018 to 14th April 2018

#### **FINANCIAL NEWS**

**SCHOOL FEES:** All outstanding fees including the 2nd term school fees are expected to be paid before **6th January**, **2016.** We encourage parents to pay the **2nd term school fee as detailed in the teller**. Parents that cannot pay the two tellers at once should pay at least one of the tellers and pay the 2nd teller on or **before the mid-term break**.

We wish to restate that you are to make the school fee payment using the school customized bank teller issued to your child(ren) and the school copies are to be returned to the Bursary on resumption day.

Kindly note that it is criminal to cancel/alter the amount written on tellers and replace with unauthorised amounts. Payments made using bank tellers not issued by the school will not be recognized by the Bursary.

The school Head of Accountant may be reached on <u>08036001113</u> pertaining school fees related issues/clarifications.

**POCKET MONEY:** It is mandatory for all students to have pocket money deposited with the Bursary Department. The school releases **N500:00** per week to each student from their pocket money account in order to meet some minor school needs. The exception to this are **resumption and visiting weeks.** We only disburse pocket money to students who were not visited on such occasions.

Since we operate a twelve-week term and disburse N500 per week to each student, it implies that N6000 is needed as pocket money per term. The students spending profile for the term is contained in the pocket money statement-of-account found online in your child's portal. Parents are encouraged to check the balance of their children and add the differential to make it a minimum of N6000 balance.

**PTA Termly Levy:** We write to remind you of the need to come along with the sum of **N1500** being payment for PTA dues and students' welfare

scheme. This is a termly payment payable to designated PTA officials on resumption day.
