ACADEMIC MATERIALS/LIST OF TEXTBOOKS FOR 2016/2017 SESSION

Parents are to ensure that their children resume school with all the recommended text books of their new classes. The list of recommended text books can be downloaded or printed via the school website www.jickaduna.com.ng.

School customized exercise books will be available for sale in the school shop during the holiday or on resumption day. Only the school customized note books will be recognized by the teachers.

TAKE HOME ASSIGNMENT

Attached to this newsletter are holiday take home assignments per subject for the students. The take home assignment will form the integral part of the welcome test that begins on 11th September 2017. We plead that you ensure that while the children rest, they also make very good use of the break by studying at home. The take-home assignment should be solved in students' test and assignment note book per subject.

UNIFORM

Parents are advised to co-operate with the school in ensuring that students dress properly in school and even at home in line with our moral training. Parents are therefore expected to replace the female skirts that are

above the knee and the male pencil trousers. We do not allow fitted-wears for both boys and girls. Parents should please ensure that all students' wears have their names stitched on. Stitching of names on uniforms include all inner wears. Our students know the correct specifications.

The correct shoes for classes are any pair of black shoes with flat sole, **complete-cover**, not semi-covered shoes, while brown sandals are the correct footwear for compound wear. Visit our website to see samples of shoes.

MOSQUITO NET

All students are to resume with a mosquito treated net. No student will be admitted back to school without the mosquito treated net as the college will make it compulsory for all students to sleep inside their net. No student will be allowed to sleep in the hostel without using his or her mosquito treated net. Students are also to resume with the sticks to tie the net.
